2020 School Fees

Our school fees are set after careful consideration by the Catholic Education office, the school and with consultation and approval of the St Bede's Community Council. In 2020 the total cost of fees for one child at St Bede's will be \$2,428.00, an increase of 3.53% (\$82.80) on 2019 fees. This amount is \$121.00 less than the average for a primary school child attending a NSW Catholic primary school in the Archdiocese of Canberra and Goulburn. Every year we do our utmost to minimise rises in school fees.

As always, if you are experiencing difficulty with payment of school fees you are welcome and encouraged to contact the school. All information provided remains strictly confidential. It is the policy of our school that no student should be refused enrolment, excluded or disadvantaged because their family is unable to afford school fees.
